

#### **PPP Model**

Private Public Partnership Hospital Projects play a key role in the Healthcare Transformation of Turkey with the construction of massive hospitals all across Turkey.

### **30 City Hospitals**

Turkey has invested approximately \$ 35 billion for 30 City Hospitals and 2 Physiotherapy Hospitals. 23 of these hospitals are already underway. Remaining hospitals are going to be completed by 2023.

### **Business Opportunity**

City Hospital Constructors require significant funding from banks.
This is an opportunity for non-Turkish companies, as the Constructor Company has to use the medical products
- in a certain extent - of the country from where the credit is sourced.



Prof. Dr. Recep Akdağ, Minister of Health of Turkey, said that healthcare spending demonstrates a country's investment in development. Akdağ noted that funders must consider this as a development item and continued: "This program, called Health Transformation, has proved highly successful over the last 10 years."





Originally launched with 23 City Hospitals out of 30 City Hospitals, the total budget allocated for the City Hospitals Project is \$35 billion so far. The goal is to increase the existing public hospital bed capacity of 162,000 to 230,000 by 2023. Developed through the PPP model, these smart, energy-efficient, base-isolated and digital hospitals are certain to be the talk of the year until the end of 2017.
